Services: Boys Town provides School & Family Support Services (SFSS) primarily to Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> Grade children attending one of 48 participating schools in Palm Beach County. Children must be identified as “at risk” for behavioral, social and/or emotional problems through a screening process. Families found eligible for the program will be contacted by their school’s Family Consultant to assess the family’s willingness to participate in the programs in-home and in-school services. The Boys Town intervention services are voluntary and provide a FREE 10-12 week program designed to help families prevent small problems from becoming bigger ones. Extensively trained Family Consultants will work with parents, as well as school personnel, to aid them in helping their children find effective solutions for various issues. The Family Consultant is available to the families they serve on a 24/7 basis.

In addition, on a time limited basis the Family Consultants will be able to provide outreach to students who may need social, emotional, or behavioral services but do not meet program eligibility criteria. This may include referral information for additional needed services to other local resources.

The child must be in Kindergarten or 1<sup>st</sup> Grade at participating schools and found to be at risk to be eligible for the full School & Family Support Services Program. In the Glades area, the following elementary schools have the program: K.E. Cunningham/Canal Point, Gladeview, Belle Glade, Gove, Pahokee, Pioneer Park, and Rosenwald.

*Out-of-School Care Provider Consortium* – PRIME TIME facilitates monthly meetings of the Out-of-School Consortium where after-school providers share best practices, learn about new policy developments and build relationships. Consortium members have free access to the Resource Center which contains school-age curricula, literature and audio-visual materials.

*Out-of-School Care Steering Committee* – The Committee is comprised of community-based, county and city sponsored school-based, faith-based and private after-school care providers. The Committee provides PRIME TIME with feedback on issues and challenges facing all after-school care providers in Palm Beach County.
